Transfer Advantage Checklist:

- Visit the Bearcat ID Office to take your Bearcat Card photo, if you haven't already.
- Verify your enrollment in CatPAWS between Aug. 15 - 26.
- Pick up your textbooks at The Station. Be sure to verify your enrollment in CatPAWS first and take your Bearcat Card with you. If you pick up your books on Thursday, you will need to walk to The Station to avoid Move-In Day traffic.
- Complete your parking permit registration in CatPAWS if you plan to have a vehicle on campus. Then, pick up your parking permit at Student Account Services. You will need to know the make, model and license plate information of the vehicle you are using while on campus. Be sure to take your Bearcat Card!
- □ Sign the Laptop Agreement in CatPAWS, then pick up your laptop. Be sure to take your Bearcat Card!
- □ Start using your meal membership. Your membership is active beginning Thursday, Aug. 22.
- □ Check your Northwest email account daily.


