Board of Regents
Work Session Minutes
September 7, 2023

The Northwest Missouri State University Board of Regents held a Work Session at 1:00 p.m. on September 7, 2023, in the J.W. Jones Student Union Boardroom pursuant to public notice given August 31, 2023.
