TEAMWORK - Work together to encourage initiative and collaboration.

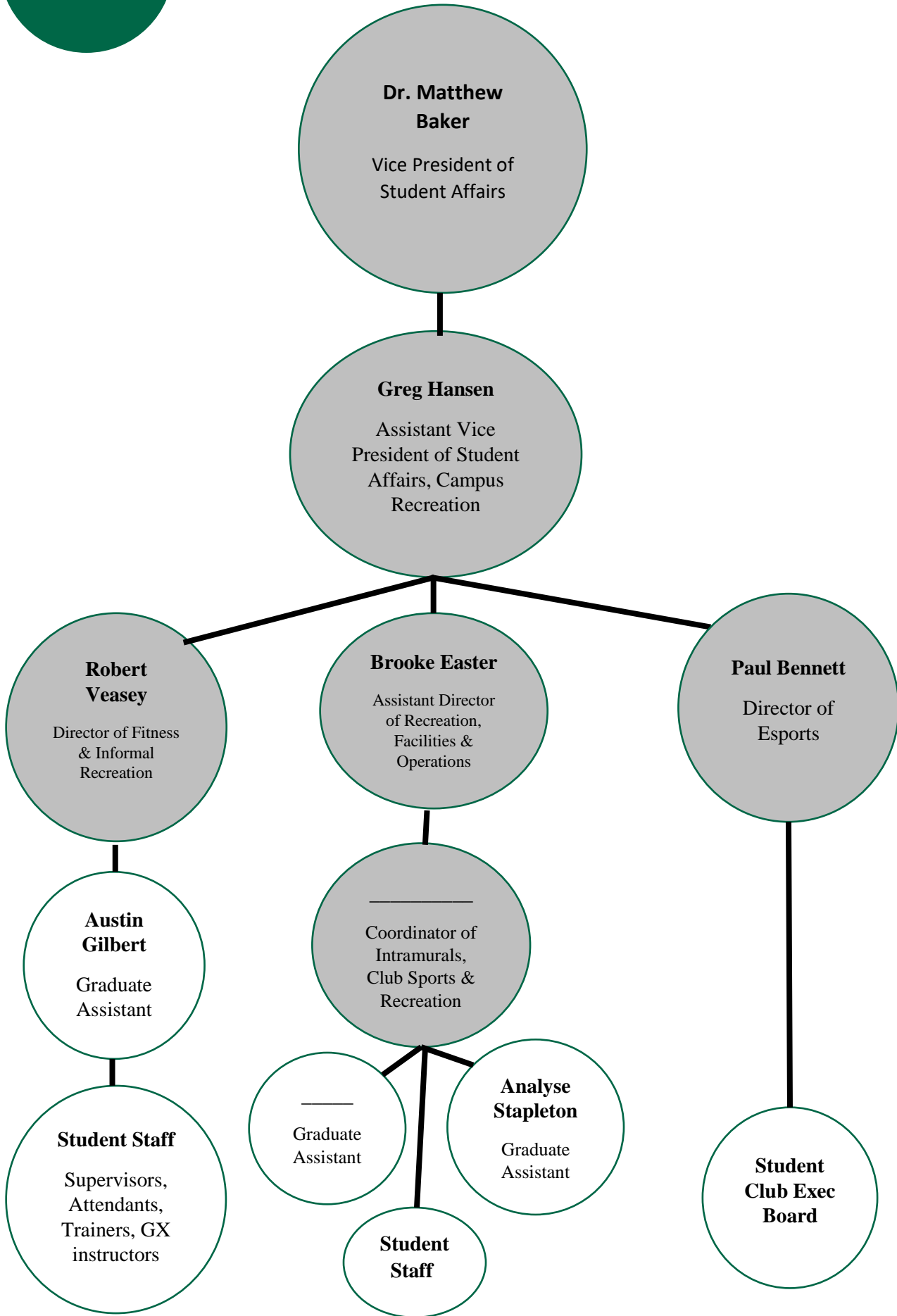
RESPECT - Foster an inclusive environment that welcomes each individual.

EXCELLENCE - Maintain high standards through unbeatable facilities, programs, and services that celebrate our success.

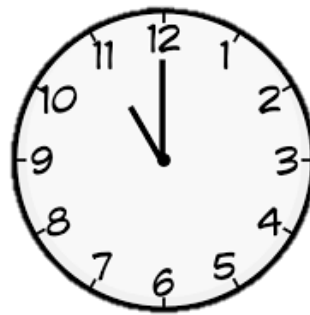

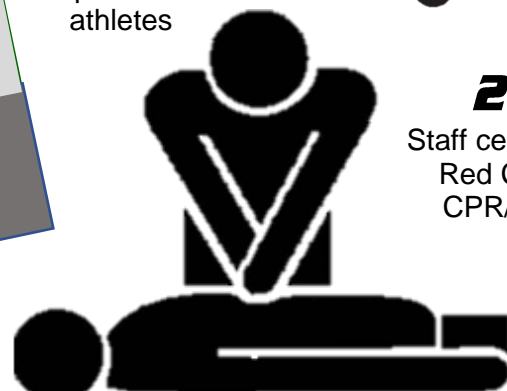

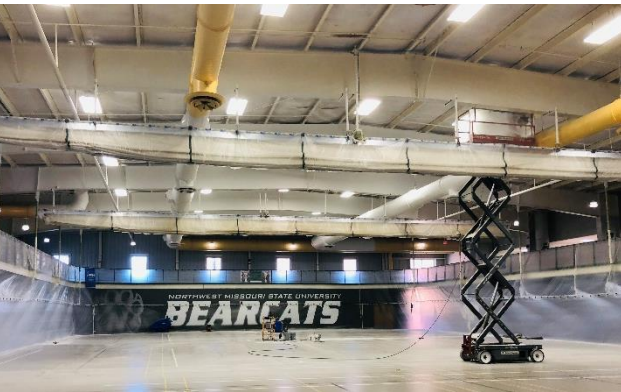
