Upward Bound is a federally-funded program which assists students, grades 9 through 12, in finishing high school and preparing them for the successful completion of a postsecondary education.

Upward Bound has been sponsored by Northwest Missouri State University since 1986 and serves selected schools in Atchison, Gentry, and Nodaway counties in Missouri.

Upward Bound participants find their academic careers and social lives enriched by Saturday Academies, college visits, and special activities scheduled throughout the academic year.

In addition, Upward Bound sponsors an annual six-week, on-campus summer residential program for its members.

What we do

Tutorial assistance for improvement of academic grades and skills. Academic enrichment courses such as:

English	Math
Science	Social Science
Writing	Foreign Language

Computers Financial Literacy

Academic, career, and personal counseling.

Leadership training and development opportunities.

Assistance with obtaining information about postsecondary institutions and their academic programs.

Assistance with college admissions, ACT testing, financial aid, scholarships and dual credit expenses.
